

FACULTY OF KINESIOLOGY

KNES 441/443/445 is a senior-level half course that is designed to provide students with "hands-on" experience in a real world professional setting prior to graduation. Students are given the opportunity to translate theory into practice for professional growth and development under the guidance of qualified professionals. Each practicum is open to current Kinesiology students in their third or fourth year (or 20 HCE) who have completed at least one semester in good standing at the University of Calgary. Students currently on probation will not be considered for the practicum program.

Practicum placements are unpaid positions and must total 60-72 hours within the framework of a given term. The On-Site Supervisor/s and students can confer upon a work schedule that suits both their needs. Practica are graded on a Credit/Fail basis.

Students may take up to three practicum courses in their program; a maximum of two are allowed within the same organization/program. Therefore, KNES 441 denotes first-time placements; KNES 443 denotes second-time placements and KNES 445 denotes third-time placements.

Practica can occur during the fall, winter or spring academic sessions.
