## **General Information and Policies**

**NOTE:** Medical Elective Awards are for students in the Faculty of Medicine MD program only.

**Application:** Application forms for Medical Elective Awards are available from the Student Awards and Financial Aid website by the end of January each year: www.ucalgary.ca/awards/ Application must be made on the current application form.

**Deadline: April 1** Unless otherwise stated, completed applications for these awards must be postmarked or received by the Student Awards and Financial Aid office on or before April 1.

Unless otherwise stated, the following policies are in effect in order to qualify for University administered awards:

- Monetary awards are provided directly to the student once completion of the elective(s) has been confirmed by the UME Office. Students must
  first provide an approved copy of the elective form, as well as, confirmation of acceptance by the hospital/clinic where the elective is to take
  place. In the event that the elective has already been completed prior to receiving notification of the award from the Student Awards and Financial
  Aid office, the student must provide a copy of the approved elective form.
- Should the student change the dates or focus of the elective study, they must provide a copy of the change to the Student Awards office as it may affect their eligibility for the award.
- If a student is granted an award, the University of Calgary reserves the right to release pertinent information to award donors, high schools, provincial funding bodies, U of C faculty and administrative offices and public news agents. Specific information may be used for U of C promotional purposes.

The University assumes liability for the payment of scholarships, bursaries, prizes and other awards only to the extent that gifts from donors, or returns from particular investments for these purposes will permit.

As this information is published a considerable time before the opening of the session, the University reserves the right to make whatever changes circumstances may require, including cancellation or addition of particular awards.
