Deadline: April 1

Unless otherwise stated, completed online applications for these awards must be submitted on or before April 1.

- Should the student change the dates or focus of the elective study, they must provide a copy of the change to the Student Awards office as it
 may affect their eligibility for the award.
- If a student is granted an award, the University of Calgary reserves the right to release pertinent information to award donors, high schools, provincial funding bodies, U of C Faculty and administrative offices and public news agents. Specific information may be used for U of C promotional
 purposes.
- Preference will be given to students taking electives between January 1, 2007 and December 31, 2007. Electives taken prior to January 1, 2007 may not be considered.
