- Engineering Student Society (ESS) fee:
Full-time Engineering Students pay a mandatory \$10.00 fee per term. In addition, a \$25.00 per term optional levy (students may opt out) is included for every undergraduate engineering student.
- Spring or Summer Terms: full-time status is two half courses (two 3 unit courses). Part-time status is one half course (one 3 unit course).
- Mandatory \$75.00 per term fee for all Law students.
- A Student Services Fee of \$225.00 per term for full-time students and \$75.00 per term for part-time students (prorated for Spring and Summer Terms) has been approved. See P.1.13.3 for more information on this fee.
- An additional \$236.43 will be assessed for 200-, 300-, and 400-level Commerce courses (excluding TOUR). The cost for 1 half course (3 units) is \$769.71. International students pay \$2,052.18 per 1 half course (3 units). See P.1.12 for more information on this fee.
