All activities take place on University property unless otherwise noted

- a) Anatomy Labs Faculty of Medicine instructional/educational programs.
- b) Aquatic Centre facility rental and/or instructional programs that include:
 - Swimming Lessons;
 - Water Fitness;
 - Water Sports;
 - Entry SCUBA;
 - Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certifications;
 - Lifesaving Society Lifesaving & Life Guarding Certifications; and
 - Boating Safety and Snorkeling.
- c) **Climbing Room** facility rental and/or instructional programs.
- d) **Gymnasiums & Gymnastics Centre** facility rental and/or instructional programs that include the following activities:
 - Volleyball;
 - Basketball;
 - Badminton; and
 - Gymnastics.
- e) Kananaskis Field Station instructional programs and/or meals and/or program resources and/or accommodations that include:
 - Outdoor science education programs;
 - Field trips;
 - Professional development programs;
 - Ecology education programs and;
 - Environmental education programs.

<u>NOTE:</u> - All of the Kananaskis Field Station services may be either FULL SUPPORT (which includes instruction, meals, program resource and sometimes accommodations) OR SELF DIRECTED (which includes accommodation only).

- f) Minds in Motion Instructional programs which use University facilities.
- g) **Outdoor Program Centre** instructional programs that include:
 - Avalanche Awareness Courses lecture presentations only;
 - <u>Backpacking</u> Kananaskis Country or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities;
 - Bike Repair Clinics;
 - <u>Canoeing</u> takes place at:
 - The University's pool and/or a community pool (If it takes place at the University's pool it may also include facility rental);
 - City of Calgary locations such as:
 - o Glenmore reservoir;
 - Bowness Lagoon and/or City lakes and areas where the University has a Permit to teach these activities;

- o The Bow River; and
- Kananaskis River and/or lakes and wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities.
- <u>Climbing and Bouldering</u>
- <u>Cross Country Skiing</u> takes place at:
 - City of Calgary locations where the University is contracted/permitted to teach these activities; and
 - Kananaskis Country or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities
- <u>Glacier Hiking/Mountaineering Skills</u> Equipment rental and/or instructional programs which take place at:
 - Kananaskis Country;
 - Banff Park; or
 - Wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities.
- <u>Guiding Services</u> for hiking trips or interpretative walks which take place at:
 - Kananaskis Country or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities.
- <u>In-Line Skating</u> takes place on University property.
- <u>Kayaking</u> takes place at:
 - The University's pool and/or a community pool (If it takes place at the University's pool, it may also include facility rental);
 - Glenmore reservoir;
 - Bowness Lagoon and/or city lakes;
 - The Bow River;
 - Kananaskis River or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities.
- <u>Mountain Biking</u> may take place:
 - On University property; and
 - Other trail areas within the City of Calgary; or
 - Kananaskis Country or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities.
- <u>Outdoor Rock Climbing</u> Kananaskis Country.
- <u>Sea Kayaking</u> takes place at:
 - The University's pool or community pool (If it takes place at the University's pool, it may also include facility rental);
 - Glenmore reservoir;
 - Bowness Lagoon and/or city lakes;
 - The Bow River; and
 - Kananaskis River or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities.
- <u>Snow Shelters</u> takes place at Fortress Mountain.
- <u>Snowshoeing</u> takes place at:
 - City of Calgary parks; or
 - Kananaskis Country.
 - Stand Up Paddle Boarding takes place at:
 - The University's pool (it may also include facility rental) and/or;
 - A community pool, and/or
 - City lakes and any other areas where the University is contracted/permitted to teach these activities.

- Outside of the City of Calgary, areas may include:
 - o The Bow River;
 - Kananaskis River or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities.
- <u>Telemark Skiing</u> takes place at:
 - Fortress or Nakiska (not including any areas with avalanche hazard)
- <u>Whitewater Rafting and/or River Rafting</u> takes place on the:
 - Bow River;
 - Red Deer River;
 - Kootenay River or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities.

h) Racquet Centre

- Facility rental and/or instructional programs.
- i) Rothney Astrophysical Observatory, Priddis, Alberta
 - Instructional/educational programs.
- j) Skating takes place at
 - Bowness Park; and
 - The Olympic Oval (which may include facility rental and/or instructional programs).
- k) Sports Clinics which may include:
 - Football clinics and/or training camps;
 - Basketball clinics and/or training camps; or
 - Volleyball clinics and/or training camps.
- I) Spray Lake Gymnastics Centre
 - Facility rental and instructional programs that includes gymnastics.

m) University of Calgary Community Garden

- Gardening activities that may include planting, weeding, digging, and watering.

n) University of Calgary Facility Tours

- Touring activities that may include spaces throughout the University campuses including, but not limited to, laboratories.
- Young Persons Accessing Laboratories this program uses the University's laboratories and facilities that have been deemed appropriate for youth and would include activities such as the Science Fair Mentorship Programs.
- p) Cybermentor Program this program uses the University's laboratories and facilities that have been deemed appropriate for youth. Activities may include workshops with animals and chemicals deemed age-appropriate.
