This \$300 million construction project for the Province of Alberta is scheduled for completion in the Spring of 2007.

The new Courts Centre comprises two high rise towers. A spacious atrium extending for the full height of the building will interconnect the two towers and, when complete, will form the highest enclosed atrium in North America.

All attendees are requested to meet by *not later than 6:00 pm* on the grassed open space in front of the entrance to the old sandstone building. This entrance is located off 7th Avenue SW, near the corner of 5th Street SW, Calgary and immediately opposite the City TV studios (previously the A Channel studios).
