"Wind Power - Lot of hot air, or reality here to stay?" Presented by Peter Bubik, EIT, of PB Power Inc.

Peter Bubik will present an overview of the wind power industry today, and will look at the technology involved and process for building a wind power project from the ground up. Two projects currently being built will be examined as case studies of wind power development in Canada and will provide a glimpse of where the industry is heading in the near future.

Peter has been interested in wind power since childhood. During his undergraduate studies, Peter landed an internship position at OEM Development in Boston, MA working on developing control systems for wind farms and other renewable energy projects. After completing his Mechanical Engineering degree at UofC, Peter started working with Canadian Hydro Developers in Calgary - at the time owner and operator of the largest wind farm in Canada - Cowley Ridge. Peter has been involved with Canadian Hydro in the capacity of control systems specialist, working on run-of-river hydroelectric power plants as well as monitoring wind data and exploring new areas for developing wind power projects in Southern Alberta. Currently, Peter is an independent consultant working with Hatch Optima on four major wind power projects in southern Alberta, as well as consulting for other clients in the area of wind power exploration.
