East Village Development

Abstract:

Calgary's East Village is adjacent to historic Fort Calgary in the heart of downtown. This community, once known for its rampant crime and vacant lots, has now become one of the busiest construction sites in the city. With plans to transform it into one of the most vibrant areas within the downtown core, East Village will offer some of the hippest shopping, dining, recreational and residential opportunities.

Four key projects have been identified to prepare the land for public and private sector development. These projects include: infrastructure improvements and upgrades, Fourth Street underpass construction, the rejuvenation of four heritage buildings, and environmental remediation throughout the area.

About the Speaker:

Mr. Ollenberger is President and CEO of Calgary Municipal Land Corporation (CMLC) currently responsible for all aspects of design, construction, public relations, marketing, planning and strategic direction of the Rivers Revitalization District in Calgary, Alberta including the redevelopment of East Village in downtown Calgary. As President and CEO of CMLC, he is responsible for liaison with Mayor and Council as the sole Shareholders, and works continually towards improving and expanding business operations.

He was previously President of Three Sisters Mountain Village in Canmore. Chris has also been responsible for development at SilverTip in Canmore and four award winning communities in Calgary: Hanson Ranch, Elbow Valley's Riverside, Martha's Haven and Copperfield. Project budgets for which he has been responsible range between approximately \$2M to over \$150M.
