Encana Tower - "The Bow"

Abstract:

The Bow contains many unique features: first curved diagrid system in North America; use of composite pipe columns; use of a hybrid lateral system (braced tube with coupling frames); largest monolithic pour for a commercial building raft foundation; and the use of top-down construction techniques, just to enumerate a few.

The presentation will describe the various steps in the life of the project, starting with the goal setting process, the conceptual design, the evolution of the structural system and the associated challenges which the engineers had to overcome to allow the concept to become reality.

The uniqueness of some of the details and the solutions chosen to construct them will be presented, to illustrate the complexity of the project not only from a design point of view but also from a constructability perspective. Once completed, the Bow will become the largest commercial office development in western Canada.

About the Speaker:

Adrian is a structural engineer who holds the position of associate with the firm HalcrowYolles, which he joined in 2000. Adrian's experience as a teacher and practitioner encompasses structural design, project management, construction and contract management. He has provided leadership on a variety of projects and has successfully completed over 80 construction projects covering all sectors of activity.
