“West LRT Project”

by Darrell Norton, P.Eng., The City of Calgary Transportation Infrastructure and Russel Delmar, P.Eng., Hatch Mott MacDonald

Abstract

The West LRT alignment extends eight kilometres west from the current west end of 7 Avenue S.W. downtown to 69 Street S.W. This alignment includes the addition of six new stations. Construction started in February 2010.

The talk will touch on the Procurement Processes, namely the Design Build Contract, will go into a bit of the early design and concept process, address the magnitude and strategy of Land Acquisitions within the accelerated timeline, outline Public Engagement efforts, and highlight some of the technical and administrative challenges.

About the speakers

Darrell Norton recently joined the City of Calgary as Manager, West LRT. Prior to joining the City, Darrell had a 23 year private sector career, practicing professional engineering at consulting firms providing municipal and transportation project engineering services.
