"South Health Campus"

Abstract:

The South Health Campus is located on 44 acres of land and when completed will have a total of 642 beds and the capacity to handle 800,000 ambulatory visits per year. Phase 1 includes 156,953 m² of hospital area, 15,291 m² of interstitial space, and 65,228 m² of a two level underground parkade. Services include General Medicine, General Surgery, Emergency, Psychiatry, Obstetrics, Gynecology & Women's Health, Critical Care Medicine, Neurology and Stroke Care, Pediatrics and Mental Health. Currently there are more than 1300 tradesmen on site with the structural component of the work being almost completed. The presentation will give an overview of the services provided by the hospital and will show stages of construction to date.

About the Speaker:

Scott Thompson joined EllisDon Construction Services Inc. in 1984 and has more than 29 years experience in major construction with proven experience in the management of all construction activities from the field to the office. His expertise is in the construction management type projects that require team involvement with the designers and owners from initiation.
