## "South Health Campus"

#### Abstract:

The South Health Campus is located on 44 acres of land and when completed will have a total of 642 beds and the capacity to handle 800,000 ambulatory visits per year. Phase 1 includes 156,953 m2 of hospital area, 15,291m2 of interstitial space, and 65,228 m2 of a two level underground parkade. Services include General Medicine, General Surgery, Emergency, Psychiatry, Obstetrics, Gynecology & Women's Health, Critical Care Medicine, Neurology and Stroke Care, Pediatrics and Mental Health. Currently there are more than 1300 tradesmen on site with the structural component of the work being almost completed. The presentation will give an overview of the services provided by the hospital and will show stages of construction to date.
