"Nuclear Power in Alberta"

Abstract

Bruce Power Alberta announced that it has completed its deal to buy the assets of Energy Alberta relating to nuclear power plant development. In addition, the company has filed an application with the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) to prepare a site for the potential construction of western Canada's first nuclear power plant.

This presentation will provide: a look at projected demand for electricity in Alberta, a comparison of the emission impacts of the various forms of Electricity production, a brief discussion of how Nuclear works, and where the project is now and expectations over the next couple of years

About the speakers

Mr. Cooper has been active in working on behalf of the Peace Country in a variety of ways. He was the Member of Parliament for Peace River from 1980-1994. He also served as Chief of Staff to the President of the Treasury Board of Canada, and the Chief of Staff for Jean Charest.
