HOW MOVE-IN DAY WORKS

ARRIVING BY TAXI OR RIDE SHARE? Please follow instructions on our website for what to do.

ARRIVE AT THE STAGING AREA

Arrive to campus from University Drive N.W. or 24 Ave NW. You will drive under the Red Arch and follow the signs and parking staff to the staging area. Only arrive to the staging area during your assigned move-in time. If you are moving into Crowsnest Hall or Varsity Courts, you will proceed to the passenger drop off area in front of Crowsnest Hall during your time slot.

DRIVE TO THE KEY PICK UP ZONE



Make sure you arrive during your selected arrival time. Showing up outside of your selected time will result in delaying your move-in.

Arriving After Hours?

If you are arriving after hours (between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m., log into your Residence Portal and fill out an After Hours Arrival form. The Campus Service Centre will then set up an after hours arrival check-in for you.
