LIVING AT ALOFT

It is important to note that Aloft is not a UCalgary residence building. It is a privately owned hotel with a variety of guests.

While living in Aloft, you will need to follow the Residence Services Agreement and will be held to the Residence Services Code of Conduct, see more information here: ucalgary.ca/ancillary/residence/move/residence-agreements

A few things will differ between living on-campus and living at Aloft including:

- Maintenance request/issues should be reported to the Aloft front desk
- 24-hour front desk service
- Residents living in Aloft are welcome at all residence-wide events
- UCalgary Campus security does not service this building. Call or visit the Aloft front desk for concerns or questions
- Reminder: Residents are committed to their contract at Aloft and are not able to transfer to the main campus residence.

How to get to and from Campus

Search "Aloft Calgary University" when looking on Google or Apple Maps.

Train: the station closest to Aloft is Banff Trail, which is one stop away from the University Station. All full-time students receive free transit, which includes the train, with UPass.

Walk: it's a 25-30 minute walk to the center of main campus from Aloft.

UPass

UCalgary UPass is included in student fees. It allows full-time undergraduate and graduate students to have unlimited access to Calgary Transit services.

Dining Options

If you're looking for breakfast, lunch, dinner, a coffee to go, or a snack on the run, there are food options available at Aloft (including cooking for yourself) or on main campus, offering a variety of choices for whatever you're craving.

Aloft's Options:

- Community Kitchen: A shared kitchen you can use to cook your own meals. Reach out to the front desk staff for more information
- Room Service for UCalgary residents: Aloft has a specific room service menu for UCalgary residents. A menu to order from will be left in your room
- Aloft restaurant: Aloft has an on-site restaurant where you can sit and enjoy a meal with friends or visitors

Main Campus:

The Landing, Dining Centre

The Landing has an All You Care To Eat program and serves breakfast, lunch, dinner and continuous dining between meal times, 7 days per week. With multiple fresh and healthy food options available, including gluten-free, vegan, vegetarian, and halal you can choose to eat whatever you like, whenever you like, and as much as you need to nourish yourself throughout the academic year. Laundry

The laundry facilities are conveniently located on the first and third floors. Both the washer and dryer are coin-operated, with each costing \$2 per use. Please note that the machines only accept \$1 coins (loonies).

Maintenance and Security

Aloft has a 24/7 front desk where you can put in a maintenance request. Additionally, students can ask for security or raise security concerns at the front desk.

Housekeeping

Housekeeping service will be available for purchase. A one-off cleaning is \$50 and cleaning per month (4 visits) is \$150. Please ask the front desk for more information.

Parking

There will be complimentary surface parking available. You will need to register your license plate with the front desk team. They also have underground parking that will be available for a monthly cost of \$125.

Quiet Hours

Please respect Aloft quiet hours, which are from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.

Reminder: Aloft has guests who are not students or affiliated with UCalgary, and they expect all guests to adhere to the quiet hours established by the management team.
