

Connecting Secondary Devices Using AirUC-Guest

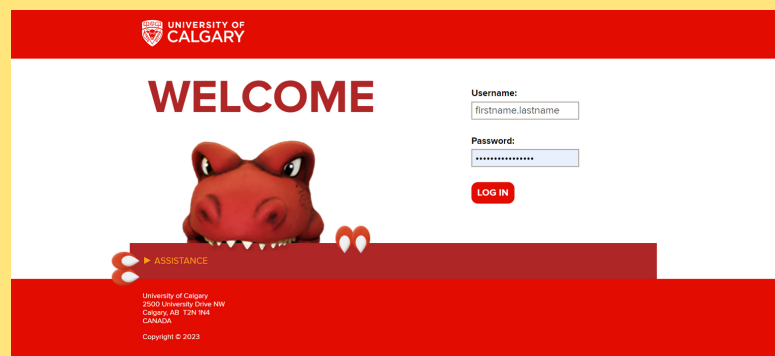


Follow these steps to get connected!

1

Navigate to the **AirUC-Guest Device Manager**.

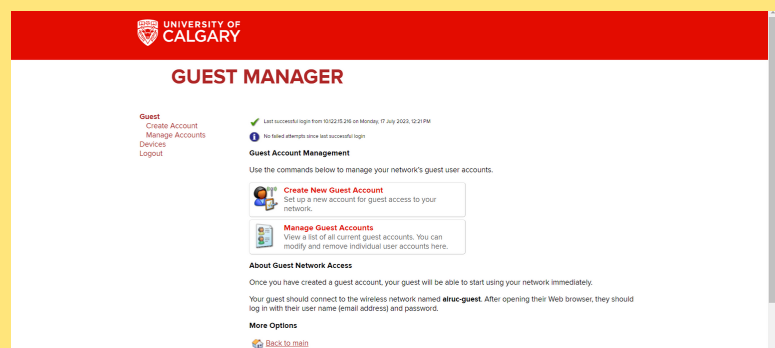
- **Login** using the **first half of your UCalgary email address** (firstname.lastname format) and the **corresponding password**.

Once logged in, you will be shown the page below to create an account with AirUC-Guest. This creates a temporary account for AirUC-Guest connections on visitor phones or laptops.

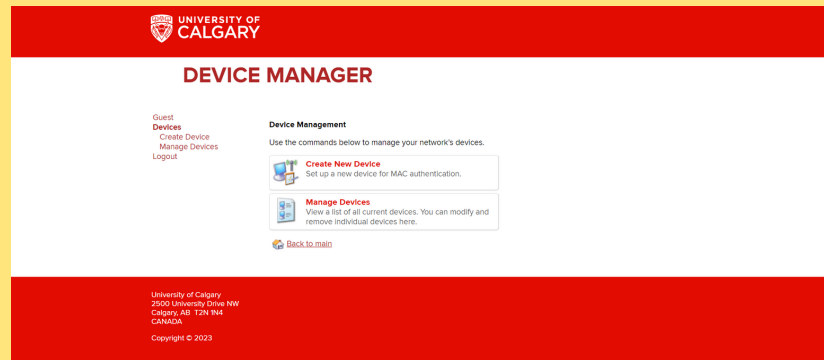
Instead, click on **Devices** from the **left menu**.

On the **Devices** page, you can:

- **Manage previously created devices** or,
- **Create a new device**

To create a new device, fill out the form as follows:

a. The **MAC address** of your device can be obtained from the system settings or some similar feature on your device.

b. The **Device Name** is an *arbitrary name* you may choose for your registered device. This name will help you keep track of the devices you have registered under AirUC-Guest.

c. You may choose to **activate** the connection at a specific time. The commonly chosen option is '**Now**'.

i. Please note, even though the activation is set to 'Now', **it may still take up to 24 hours for the device to be active on your end**. Often, **restarting** your device may help. If this still doesn't work, please contact **UService IT** for assistance.

d. You may choose an **expiration date** that best serves your purpose. The most commonly selected option is '**1 Year from Now**'.

e. Agree to the **Terms of Use**.

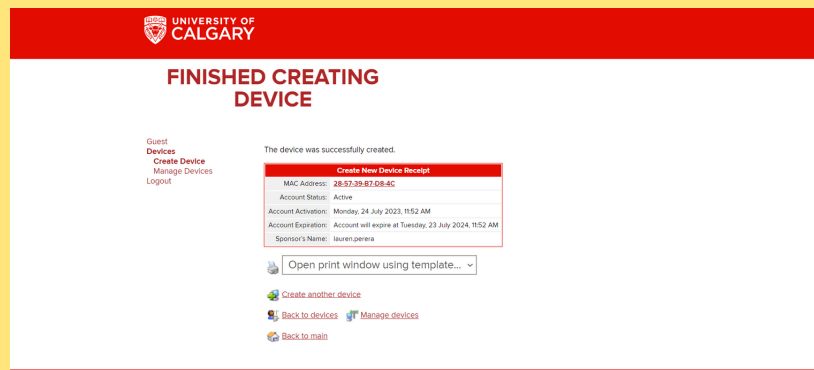

Try connecting to AirUC-Guest on your registered device.

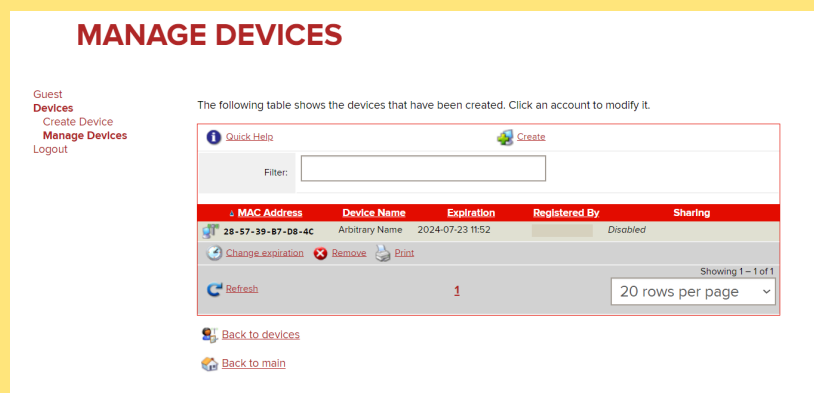

Under **Manage Devices**, you can **view** the list of devices you have previously **registered**, **register** devices directly on this page, **delete** any devices previously registered, or **extend** the expiration of any created devices by clicking on the relevant device in the list.
