

University of Calgary Motorcycle &
Moped parking
(Updated March 21, 2019)

As of August 1, 2013

2-3 wheel motor vehicles will be required to purchase a parking pass from Parking and Transportation Services on an annual basis.

Reasons for the change:

As our campus evolves the need to provide a positive, safe environment grows with it. The campus has seen a dramatic increase in motorcycle and moped vehicles being used for commuting. Although we support the sustainable nature of these vehicles, there is a need to create order and structure by having them park in designated locations around campus. This improves the safety for everyone within our campus community.

Definition:

Motor vehicle that is mounted on 2 or 3 wheels and is powered by an engine or motor. Motor can be gasoline, diesel or electric powered.

Government registration of the cycle is needed and Insurance is required to operate.

Locations of use:

This pass will permit parking of these vehicles in the designated motorcycle zones on the main U of C campus. No specific zone will be assigned. Locations will be first come, first serve.

These zones are located as follows:

Lot 14 (north of CCIT)

Lot 16 (north of the Kinesiology building)

Lot 19 (between Earth Sciences and Math Sciences)

Lot 21 (north of Math Sciences)

Lot 24 (between Social Science and Bio Science) Lot

27 (under the +15 west of Scurfield Hall) Lot

Lot 50 (by paystation)

53 (east of the Physical Plant building)

University theatre Loop (between Rozsa Centre and University Theatres)

Should all the zones be full or if a driver would prefer to use a paylot or hourly lot, then the posted fee in these locations will apply.

Outstanding tickets:

As with all permits issued on campus, if the vehicle owner has outstanding fines on campus, a permit will not be issued until those fines are paid in full.
