Full Time Hospital Neurologist

The Division of Neurology at the University of Calgary and Alberta Health Services is inviting applications for a Hospital neurologist (Neuro-hospitalist). Qualifications include an MD, a specialist certificate in Neurology from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and eligibility for licensure in the Province of Alberta. The candidate must be fellowship trained in an appropriate subspecialty or have at least one year of experience in clinical practice and training in Quality Improvement, Hospital Management, or a similar discipline.

We are seeking an individual with proven clinical excellence, a record of working well within a team, leadership skills, demonstrated interest in hospital neurology, innovative thinking, interest in leading practice improvement, and the ability to participate fully in the City-Wide call schedule. Involvement in continuing medical education, medical student and resident education will be expected. Approximately 12-15 weeks of hospital service will be required along with a mix of outpatient clinics and academic activities.

The successful applicant will be expected to qualify for an academic appointment as a Clinical Assistant Professor within the University of Calgary, Cumming School of Medicine, and the Department of Clinical Neurosciences.

In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada. Alberta Health Services and the University of Calgary are committed to employment equity.
