UCalgary has achieved global teaching and research excellence, while ensuring public funds are managed with the utmost care. We have strategically invested in new programs and initiatives while judiciously managing costs.

We spend **Less** on administration and academic support than our national peers.

More than half of our revenue comes from non-provincial sources.

Three-fourths of our research income comes from non-provincial sources. Our *Growth Through Focus* goal is to raise \$2 billion in revenue from non-provincial sources to reduce reliance on the Campus Alberta grant.
