Abstract submission deadline for review: Friday, January 14, 2011

Please forward your submission electronically to bcusitar@ucalgary.ca. The notification of acceptance will be by e-mail; travel stipends (~\$150) may be awarded to students attending from out-of-province on acceptance of their abstract proposal. Please indicate on your abstract whether a platform or poster presentation is preferred (the final decision will be made by the Program Committee on consideration of the quality of the abstract and the structural needs of the program). Qualifiers for abstract acceptance are: Originality / Research Scope / Methodology / Appeal to the Audience / Interdisciplinary Relation. Full panel proposals of 3-4 papers on a topic range are particularly welcome (e.g. surgical techniques / women in medicine / veterinary medicine).
