



## 2.1 Organization

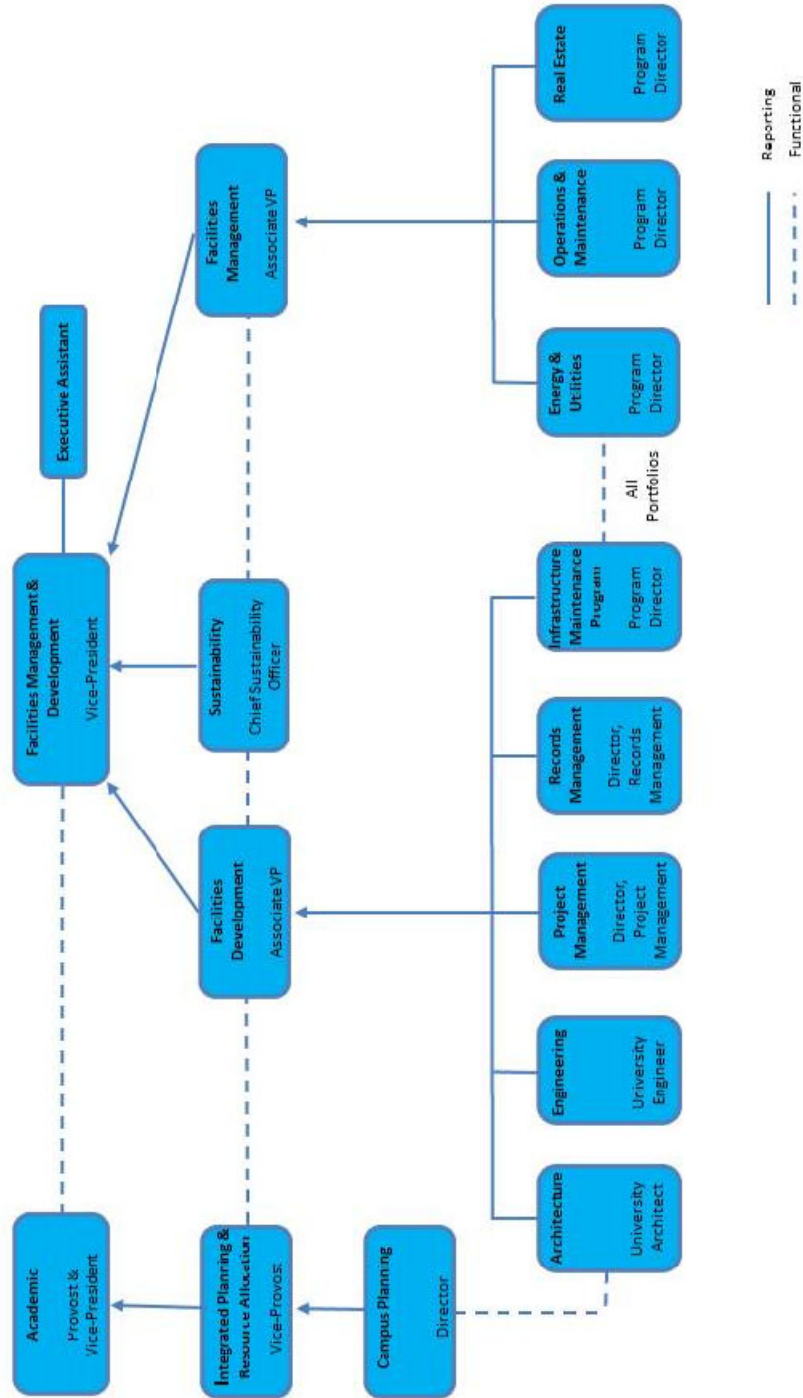
Facilities is responsible for creating, maintaining and renewing the buildings and spaces that enable the research, teaching and administrative activities of the University of Calgary.

With over 830,000 m<sup>2</sup> (8.9 million sq. ft.) of space in 115 buildings across eight sites, strategic planning is essential for the careful alignment of all Facilities resources. Bringing together the skills of architects, engineers, project managers, and trades; Facilities Management and Development provides quality environments in support of the overall goals and objectives of the U of C.
