
- Why Do I need it?
 - Organizing References
 - Easily Cite in Document
 - Keep Track of your References (resources in one place, save PDFs (highlight, etc.), archive, etc.)
 - Work on more than one computer
 - Collaborate

- **Features & Functionality**
 - Import citations from various places (direct, PDF, browser)
 - Store citations in one place & edit them (folders, annotate, edit, tag, search)
 - Share citations (shared account, user groups, online reading lists)
 - In-text citation insertion (Write-n-Cite, etc.)
 - Bibliography creation

Price	Between \$100-200 EndNote Online (free)	Free	Free
Free Space	1 GB online space on EndNote web	300MB	2GB
PDF annotation & reader	Yes	Yes	Yes
Snapshot (websites, etc.)	Yes	Yes	Yes
Learning curve	Takes longer to learn, but not difficult with training	Quick to learn; simple design, many online user guides and demos	Quick to learn; Pretty simple interface
