
- On May 29, 2023, Albertans elected a UCP government under the leadership of Premier Danielle Smith
 - UCP 49 (-13)
 - NDP 38 (+14)
 - Independent 1
- New dynamic in Legislature, as Government largely made up of representatives from outside Edmonton and Calgary



Policy Overview



Priorities:

- Relationship vis a vis Ottawa climate change focus
- Continued healthcare reform
- Bill 1 The Save Albertans' Money Act

Focus on PSE:

- PSE dialogue focussed on skills and economic development
- Linked to some extent to K-12 education



Key Commitments - PSE



- Legislate free expression on campus
- Targeted enrolment
- Graduation Retention Tax Credit-\$3,000-\$10,000; part of Alberta Job Growth and Diversification Strategy
- Align pre-employment program costs for students in K-12 with post-secondary
- Alberta is Calling Signing Bonus-\$1,200 non-refundable tax credit for targeted skilled trades and professions (healthcare, childcare, trades); eligible after one year
- Streamlined credentialing for select professions



Key Messages



UCalgary is Canada's entrepreneurial university

- One of the top research universities in Canada.
- Top startup creator amongst research institutions in Canada.
- UCalgary has a \$16.5B economic impact on the Alberta economy.
- Our new strategic plan Ahead of Tomorrow will continue to position UCalgary for the future.

UCalgary is well aligned with government priorities

- UCalgary is well positioned to grow talent/skills and to grow/diversify the economy through innovation across sectors.
- Key examples of UCalgary's leadership:
 - One Child Every Child transformative impact on child/maternal health, leading to better outcomes, policies, and cost savings - positioning Alberta as the national/international centre of excellence.
 - UCalgary is a leader in quantum transformative technology that will support ag/energy/finance/logistics sectors.

Key Messages



UCalgary is growing

- By 2031, close to 1/4 of projected post-secondary enrolment growth in Alberta will be at UCalgary.
- UCalgary could experience a shortage of over 9,500 seats by 2031 based on anticipated demand.
