

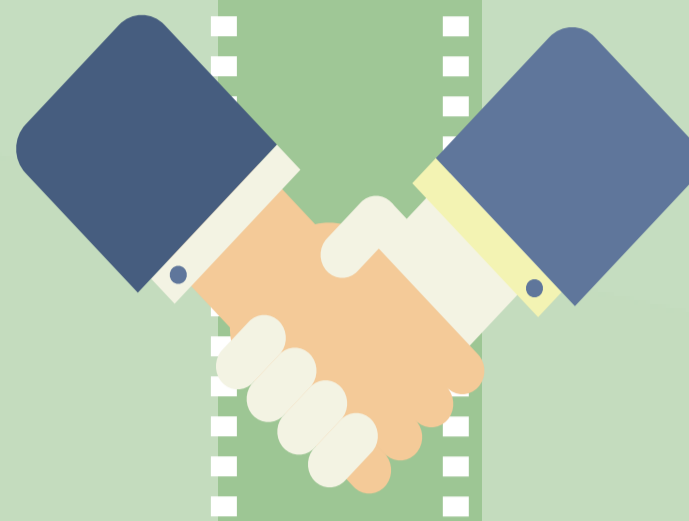
HOW TO DEVELOP AN ALL OUR FAMILIES QUESTIONNAIRE

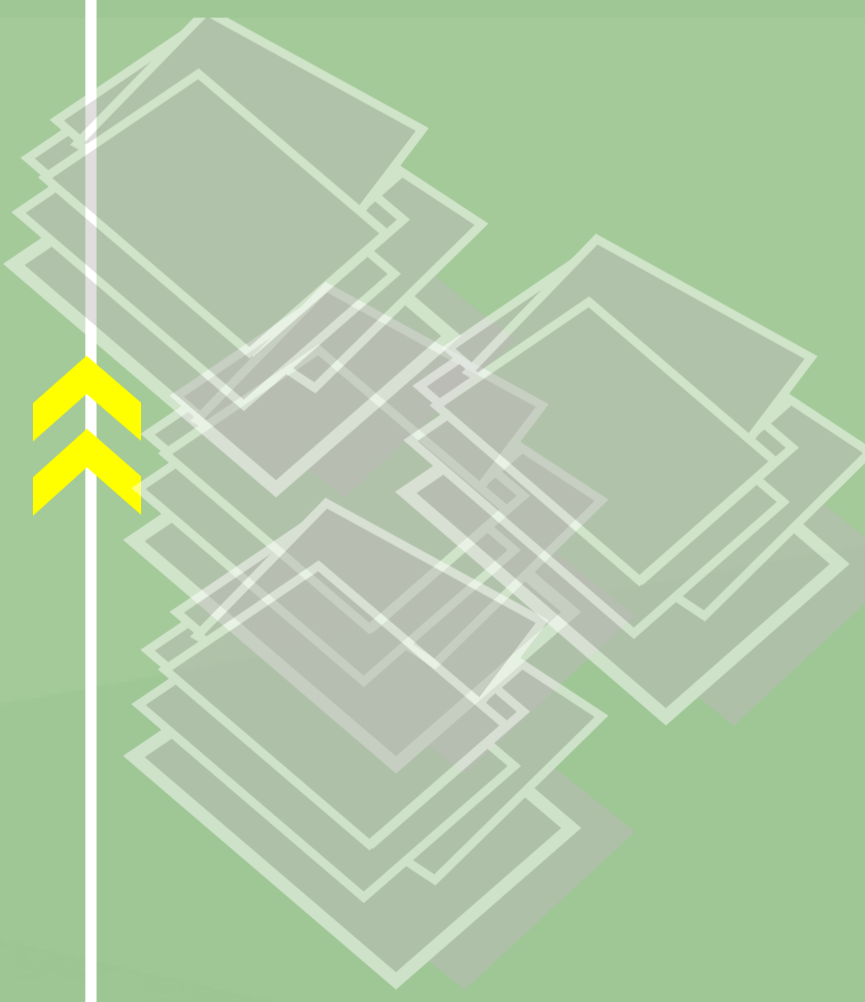

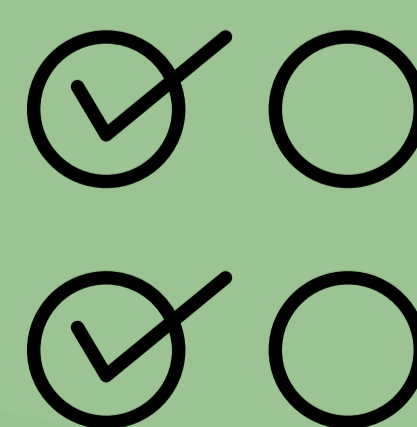
