#### **ENTRANCE AWARDS**

#### **General Information and Policies**

Entrance scholarships and bursaries are available to students entering their first year of post-secondary studies, who will be admitted to the University on the basis of their high school grades. Students must be entering a Fall Session at the University of Calgary. Generally recipients of awards must have achieved above average grades in five appropriate 20-level courses (grade 11) or equivalent for non-Alberta students and in some cases must demonstrate financial need. Upon completion of one year of post-secondary studies at the University of Calgary, a student is then eligible to apply for Undergraduate Awards (Deadline is June 15).

- Students entering the Bachelor of Health Sciences program in the Faculty of Medicine, are eligible to apply for Entrance Awards.
- Students entering or continuing in the Bachelor of Education (Master of Teaching Program) must apply for awards using the Competitive Undergraduate Awards application form (Deadline is June 15).

The following points should be considered when applying for Entrance Awards:

- Applicants should familiarize themselves with the kinds of scholarships and bursaries that are available to high school graduates. When filling out
  the application form, applicants should be sure to include all information that is pertinent to those awards for which they feel especially qualified.
   Note: By completing one Entrance Awards application form, applicants will be considered for all scholarships and bursaries listed in this section
  with the exception of those stating "No application required."
- Entrance Awards application forms are available from the Student Awards and Financial Aid office or Alberta high school counsellors. Application forms may also be printed off the Student Awards and Financial Aid office web site upon availability: www.ucalgary.ca/awards/ Application for awards must be made on the current application form.
- Unless otherwise stated, completed application forms for Entrance Awards must be post-marked or received by the Student Awards and Financial Aid office on or before **December 1 of the year prior to entering the University**.
- Non-Alberta students MUST attach to their awards application a transcript from their high school counsellor. Grades for Alberta students will be
  obtained electronically by the Student Awards and Financial Aid office from Alberta Learning.
- If applying for admission, students must arrange for an official transcript to be forwarded to the Registrar's Office.
- · Students need not have been accepted for admission to the University prior to applying for these awards.
- In order that awards may be equitably distributed, no student may normally hold more than one major award administered by the University of Calgary in any given year.
- Scholarships and bursaries listed under the section "Outside Awards" require that applicants fill out a separate application form, obtained from
  either the donor or the University Student Awards and Financial Aid office.

The University assumes liability for the payment of scholarships, bursaries, prizes and other awards only to the extent that gifts from donors, or returns from particular investments for these purposes will permit.

As this information is published a considerable time before the opening of the session, the University reserves the right to make whatever changes circumstances may require, including cancellation or addition of particular awards.
