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It is very important that you carefully consider the total financing of your education, from your first session at the University of Calgary to completing your degree objective. If financial help will be needed beyond funds that you or your family are able to provide, you should make the necessary applications for financial assistance well in advance of enrollment.

While the needs and resources of each student differ, the University can provide a general list of fees and expenses normally encountered.

We have also provided a listing of average costs for various items and services you might require while living in Calgary.






