

OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

General Information and Policies

Application: Complete the High School Awards online application, available through the myUofC portal: <https://my.ucalgary.ca> (PeopleSoft Student Centre). Students may also access the portal from the U of C home page or the Student Awards and Financial Aid office.

Deadline: Submit the online High School Awards application on or before **December 15 of the year prior to entering the University**.

- Two Academic Reference forms are to be completed and sent to the Student Awards and Financial Aid office by January 15th.
- Non-Alberta** students **MUST** mail or fax their **high school transcript** to the Student Awards and Financial Aid office by January 15th. Grades for Alberta students will be obtained electronically by the Student Awards and Financial Aid office from Alberta Learning, providing an accurate Alberta Learning ID number is entered on their application for admission to the U of C.

Outstanding Achievement Awards are available to students entering their first year of post-secondary studies, who will be admitted to the University on the basis of their high school grades. Students must be entering a Fall Session at the University of Calgary.

Please Note:

- Upon submitting the online High School Awards application, students will also be considered for Entrance Awards.
- Students entering the Bachelor of Health Sciences program in the Faculty of Medicine are eligible to apply for Outstanding Achievement Awards.
- Students entering or continuing in the Bachelor of Education (Master of Teaching Program) are NOT eligible to apply for Outstanding Achievement Awards, however, they are eligible to apply for Competitive Undergraduate Awards; Deadline is August 1.
- Upon completion of consecutive Fall and Winter Sessions at the University of Calgary, students are then eligible to apply for the Competitive Undergraduate Awards.

The following points should be considered when applying for Outstanding Achievement Awards:

- Students must normally have earned a minimum average of 88.0% throughout high school to apply for Outstanding Achievement Awards.
- Students are strongly encouraged to review the *High School Awards Online Application Information*, provided on the Student Awards and Financial Aid website, prior to applying for helpful hints and required information.
- Chancellor's Club Scholarships are renewable in the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th year; based on a minimum 3.50 grade point average on a normal full-course load each year.
- Although students need not have applied for admission to the University prior to applying for these awards, they must have applied for admission in order to be offered awards within this competition.
- Successful applicants will be notified late March.
- Unsuccessful applicants will be notified early April.
- Unless otherwise stated in the conditions, awards are payable only when the student is in actual full-time attendance at the University of Calgary; recipients must maintain full-time status.
- In support of the Academic Plan, awards are distributed among the most deserving students and in keeping with the terms of reference for awards. No student may normally receive total award funds of more than the value equivalent to the average cost of attendance as calculated by the Student Awards and Financial Aid office, unless the value of the award is higher.
- If a student is granted an award, the University of Calgary reserves the right to release pertinent information to award donors, high schools, provincial funding bodies, U of C Faculty and administrative offices and public news agents. Specific information may be used for U of C promotional purposes.

The University assumes liability for the payment of scholarships, bursaries, prizes and other awards only to the extent that gifts from donors, or returns from particular investments for these purposes will permit.

As this information is published a considerable time before the opening of the session, the University reserves the right to make whatever changes circumstances may require, including cancellation or addition of particular awards.
