SUBJECT: Flexible Grading for Fall 2020 Term

On December 1, 2020 the Academic Planning and Priorities Committee approved the use of the CR grade or unweighted D/D+ option for one course completed during the Fall 2020 term as follows:

Undergraduate students:

- Students who receive a grade of C- and above in a single course can choose a CR option. A single course can be one of a 3-unit, 1.5 unit, 1 unit or .75 unit course. OR
- Students who receive a grade of D or D+ in a single course can select an unweighted D* or D+* grade that will not be included in a student's GPA. A single course can be one of a 3-unit, 1.5 unit, 1 unit or .75 unit course.

Graduate students:

- Students who receive a grade of B- and above in a single course can choose a CR option. A single course can be one of a 3-unit, 1.5 unit, 1 unit or .75 unit course.

The Office of the Registrar will outline the procedure for students to follow that will be communicated to all students via email and will be posted on the grades information page at <https://www.ucalgary.ca/registrar/student-centre/grades>.

The following conditions will be followed for the CR option for Fall 2020:

- Undergraduate students may request a CR grade for a single course where the final grade is a C- and above. A single course can be one of a 3-unit, 1.5 unit, 1 unit or .75 unit course. OR
- Undergraduate students: Students who receive a grade of D or D+ in a single course can select an unweighted D* or D+* grade that will not be included in a student's GPA. A single course can be one of a 3-unit, 1.5 unit, 1 unit or .75 unit course.
- Graduate students may request a CR grade for a single course where the final grade is a B- and above. A single course can be one of a 3-unit, 1.5 unit, 1.0 unit or .75 unit course.
- once the request is made it cannot be reversed;
- January 15, 2021 is the deadline for students to request the CR/unweighted D+/D option for a Fall 2020 term course.
- a course where the CR is applied will not count towards a student's GPA;
- F grades will remain unchanged and will be used to calculate a student's GPA.
- Will apply to any course scheduled during the Fall 2020 term (regular, block week, non-standard)
- Any courses that are scheduled over both the fall and winter terms are exempt at this time.
