

SUMMARY

There have been eight positive cases of covid-19 on campus on September 12-15, 2021.

Case A

An individual who spent time in Science B, Science Theatres and the EEEL building tested positive for covid-19. Their infectious window on campus was September 13 & 14. Contact tracing is complete and close contacts have been identified.

Case B

An individual who spent time at the W.A. Ranch tested positive for covid-19. Their infectious window on campus was September 12 & 13. Contact tracing is complete and no close contacts have been identified.

Case C

An individual who spent time in Rundle Hall, Murray Fraser Hall, ICT, Dining Centre, Kinesiology A & B tested positive for covid-19. Their infectious window on campus was September 13, 14 & 15. Contact tracing is complete and one close contact has been identified.

Case D

An individual who spent time in Science B and Science Theatres tested positive for covid-19. Their infectious window on campus was September 13 & 15. Contact tracing is complete and no close contacts have been identified.

Case E

An individual who spent time in EEEL, Science B and Science Theatres tested positive for covid-19. Their infectious window on campus was September 13 & 14. Contact tracing is complete and no close contacts have been identified.

Case F

An individual who spent time in ICT, Science B and Engineering C tested positive for covid-19. Their infectious window on campus was September 13, 14 & 15. Contact tracing is complete and one close contact has been identified.

Case G

An individual who spent time in Kinesiology tested positive for covid-19. Their infectious window on campus was September 15. Contact tracing is complete and one close contact has been identified.

Case H

An individual who spent time in Math Sciences tested positive for covid-19. Their infectious window on campus was September 15. Contact tracing is complete and one close contact has been identified.

STEPS TAKEN

Areas where the affected individual is known to have spent time are being deep cleaned. If you have not heard from AHS or the University of Calgary, you are not believed to be a close contact. Please contact Health Link at 8-1-1 with any questions.

Positive results from a covid-19 test should be reported by emailing ohn@ucalgary.ca. Continue to isolate as directed by AHS.

We would like to remind our campus community of the updated [isolation guidance for employees and students](#) which include a guide of when to come on campus. Please do not come to campus if you are experiencing any cold or flu-like symptoms and go home immediately if symptoms develop while you are on campus. **Anyone who is awaiting results of covid-19 test should continue to isolate, even if symptoms resolve before test results are known. You can return to campus if you are not a close contact, symptoms resolve and you have received a negative COVID test result.**

Please remember the best methods to prevent the spread of covid-19 include maintaining a 2-metre distance from others at all times, wearing a mask, frequent hand washing and vaccination. All Albertans age 12 and older are now eligible to book appointments through AHS or a participating pharmacy provincewide. [Learn more.](#)

As per exposure criteria established by Alberta Health, a close contact is anyone who, during the infectious period has lived with or was within two metres of a person who has COVID-19 for 15 minutes, even if a non-medical mask was worn during that contact. This includes cumulative contact where multiple interactions add up to 15

minutes or more. A close contact could also be someone who had direct physical contact (handshake, hugging, kissing) with an infectious person or direct contact with their bodily fluids, such as being coughed or sneezed on. Wearing a non-medical mask is not sufficient to exempt you from being considered a close contact. [Learn more.](#)

To keep our community informed and safe, the University of Calgary sends covid-19 notices for cases we have been made aware of that may affect our community. If you believe you may have been exposed to this case (within two meters for 15+ minutes without a barrier): immediately isolate, [complete the AHS self-assessment](#) and obtain a covid-19 test, and email ohn@ucalgary.ca.
