| <ul> <li>Evacuation Procedures</li> <li>Activate the NEAREST fire alarm pull station</li> <li>Take coat, keys and identification if immediately available</li> <li>Evacuate building through the nearest exit: use stairs - DO NOT USE ELEVATORS</li> <li>Close all doors along your exit route</li> <li>If directed by wardens, follow their instructions</li> </ul>  | <ul> <li>Suspicious Items</li> <li>If in doubt of contents DO NOT TOUCH, MOVE, OPEN OR DISTURB THE ITEM</li> <li>Turn off all wireless devices as they could accidentally set off the suspicious item</li> <li>Immediately contact Campus Security at 403-220-5333 or the Police at 9-1-1</li> <li>Wait a safe distance away from the area for Campus Security or emergency services to arrive</li> </ul>   |
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| <ul> <li>Move away from the building and proceed to the Assembly Point</li> <li>If you have information regarding the emergency call Campus Security at<br/>403-220-5333 from a safe location</li> </ul>   | <ul> <li>Threatening Calls (including Bomb Threats)</li> <li>Listen and remain calm, do not interrupt the caller</li> <li>Record/document as much information as you can while the call is in progress</li> </ul>   |
| <ul> <li>Shelter in Place – Severe Storms</li> <li>Take shelter in a small interior room, closet or hallway (ground floor, if possible)</li> <li>Stay away from outside walls, windows and doors</li> </ul>  | <ul> <li>Signal someone to call Campus Security at 403-220-5333 or the Police at 9-1-1 or do so yourself using a different line if possible</li> <li>Utilize call trace if on cell-phone or off-campus phone (key *69)</li> </ul>   |
| <ul> <li>Do not use elevators</li> <li>Stay close to the ground and protect your head from flying objects</li> <li>If outdoors and unable to safely get inside, lie in a ditch or low-lying area or crouch near a building</li> </ul>  | <ul> <li>Hazard Materials Spill</li> <li>Only attempt to clean up a spill you are comfortable dealing with</li> <li>Follow the appropriate spill response procedures and report using OARS</li> <li>Contact Campus Security at 403-220-5333 if you require assistance to clean up a</li> </ul>  |
| Armed Assailant on Campus <ul> <li>Be aware of your environment, plan, know your exits, assess the situation, and</li> </ul>   | spill <ul> <li>Remain available to provide information to responders</li> </ul>   |
| <ul> <li>a be affaited by your difficulties (plant) into a your difficulties the order of (plant) and react quickly</li> <li>a Choose Action over Fear while considering the three main options</li> <li>b Get Out - if you are in close proximity to an armed assailant, run away from the subject</li> <li>b Hide - if you cannot flee, or do not know the location of the shooter, hide in a locked or barricaded room and turn out the lights</li> <li>c Fight – if confronted by the shooter, as a last resort, fight for survival.</li> <li>c Improvise weapons to disarm and incapacitate the shooter.</li> </ul> | <ul> <li>Acts or Threats of Violence</li> <li>Attempt to distance yourself from the person if possible</li> <li>If the person(s) have left the immediate area, lock your door and/or move to a safe place</li> <li>Contact Campus Security at 403-220-5333 as soon as possible and follow directions provided</li> <li>If the threat was delivered by electronic or in hard copy means, do not destroy and contact Campus Security at 403-220-5333</li> </ul> |
