

BIOGRAPHY – Jeff Davison

Born and raised in Calgary, Jeff Davison is best known for his skill at bringing people together, finding common ground, and building policies and programs that work for everyone. Jeff is currently Chief Executive Officer of the Prostate Cancer Centre, an innovative model for medical access and wrap-around clinical care for individuals with prostate and other urological cancer in Alberta.

Having spent over twenty years with publicly traded companies in the energy, technology and creative services sectors, Jeff was elected to Calgary City Council from 2017 – 2021. During his time on council, Jeff co-developed the City of Calgary economic strategy and the \$200 million downtown recovery plan. He is intimately familiar with the challenges that our province is faced with, talent shortages and economic diversification, and fundamentally believes advanced education is key to the solution. Jeff previously served on the Board of Directors for Calgary Municipal Land Corporation, Calgary Economic Development, the Opportunity Calgary Investment Fund and the Calgary Film Centre.

As a father to three young children, Jeff is committed to helping Calgary and Alberta develop a new growth strategy that builds on our strengths as an energy hub and entrepreneurial city. He believes that balancing economic, social, and environmental priorities by challenging ourselves to do better will create a future where the next generation can flourish.
