


All students are asked by the Students' Union to make a tax deductible donation to the Student Peer Assistance Bursary program. In each term, you are automatically charged a fee: \$10.00 for each the fall and winter terms, and \$7.00 for each the spring and summer terms. Your donation provides bursaries to other students with proven financial need. Donation opt out opens 1 month before the term start.

The Health and Dental Plan is a service managed by the Student's Union and is included in your general fees. Students with proof of alternative coverage can access the opt-out through the Student Services Centre.

The following will guide you on how to opt-out of these fees.

NOTE: In both cases, you must opt-out **before the term fee deadline**.





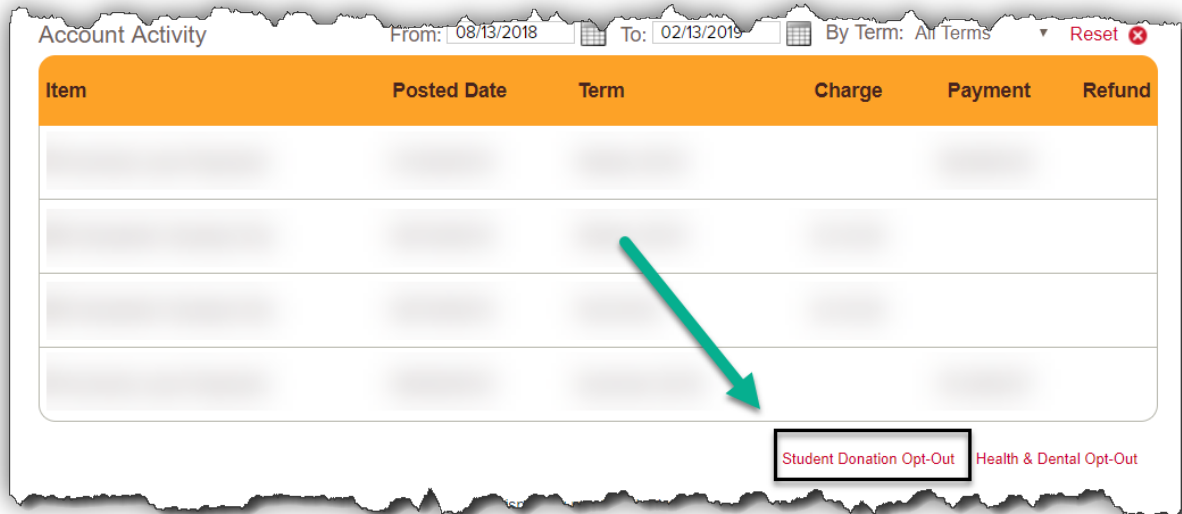
