The Winter School will offer introductory lectures on the European Union as pretext to analyze today's identity politics in Europe. Participants will therefore not only become experts on the EU's history, policy-making system and policy priorities but also discuss how decades of European governance, migration flows, and recent crises impact on European citizens' identity formation and political mobilization in societal conflict. To understand how identity politics plays out in different EU member states and the transnational realm, participants will engage in live and asynchronous discussions.
