



Alberta Indigenous Mentorship in Health Innovation (AIM-HI) Network and The Alberta First Nations Information Governance Centre First Nations, Métis and Inuit Undergraduate and Graduate Student Experiential Internship Opportunity

Project Background

The AIM-HI Network and the Alberta First Nations Information Governance Centre (AFNIGC) have collaborated with the goal of supporting Indigenous Health Research Initiatives in Alberta, which includes increasing the number of Indigenous Researchers. Through this collaboration, salary funding will be provided to First Nations, Métis and Inuit (FNMI) research undergraduate and graduate students who will support the development of proposals to be submitted to the Federal Research Granting Agencies in Canada (Canadian Institute of Health Research, Social Science and Humanities Research Council, and the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council), or complete project work within tri-council funded project or team grants.

Project Term

May 1, 2019 - September 1, 2019 (negotiable)

Award Amount

A salary of up to \$10,000.00 (\$2,500 monthly) will be awarded. No additional benefits or project costs are provided.

Activities

- FNMI undergraduate and graduate students will work under the supervision of Indigenous Health Research Principal Investigators who have been recruited by AFNIGC.
- The student will work with the Principal Investigator to develop a grant proposal for submission to one of the Federal Research Granting Agencies in Canada, or complete project work within awarded grants.
- The student will participate in AIM-HI activities during the tenure of the award.
- AFNIGC will be providing learning opportunities to further enhance research ethics knowledge.

Eligibility

- Self-identified FNMI students enrolled full-time in an Undergraduate, Masters or PhD degree program at a post-secondary academic institution in Alberta.
- Willingness to participate in AFNIGC & AIM-HI Network Training Sessions during the tenure of their award.
