## Background:

- Understanding how they cope with the situation during the time of active infection will be important to inform future support/intervention

## Method:

- Data collection through semi-structured interviews
- Thematic analysis of the transcribed interviews

### 1. Understanding the study population



- Informal meetings with Filipino
- consult with community champions

### 2. Community engagement

- meeting Filipino workers during their community activities
- collaborate with other community serving organizations

### 3. Preparing for the research with the study population



- provide safe space for community members to identify important values in the community to guide and generate the research questions

### 4. Conducting the study

- recruitment through community outreach and with the help of community champions
- semi-structured interviews

### 5. Analysis and interpretation of data

- Capacities and vulnerabilities Analysis Framework
- involving leaders and community members to contextualize the analysis results
- going back to the community and ask them how to share the results/findings



### 6. Knowledge mobilization activities

- publish results in Filipino newspaper, social networking sites
- share findings in Filipino Ethnic Network Channels
